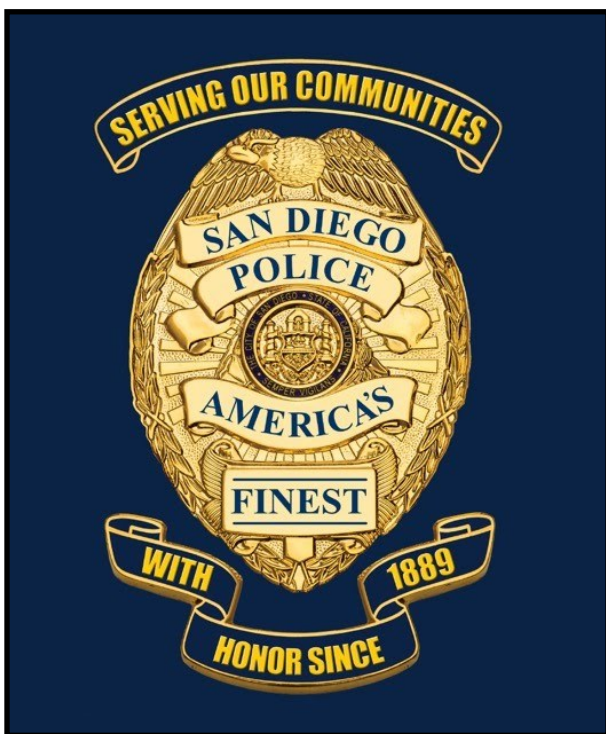


# “Crimes Against Seniors”
